Using Welsh in the Best Way Possible!

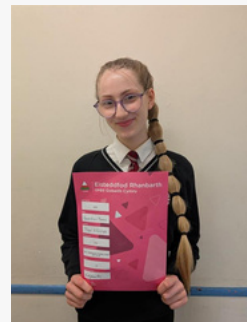

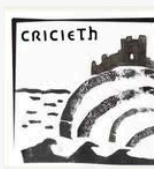


Design and Technology: Creativity, Skills, and Collaboration

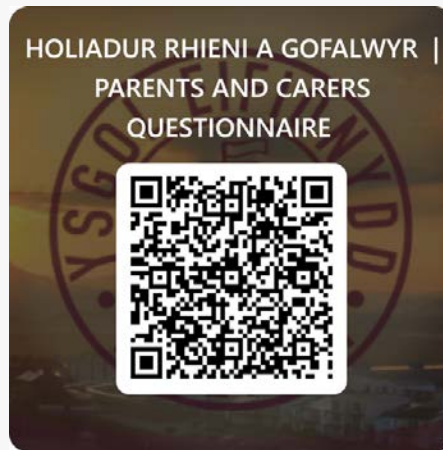

Parents/guardians should not arrange holidays during the school term. The school will not authorise term-time holidays unless exceptional circumstances apply.



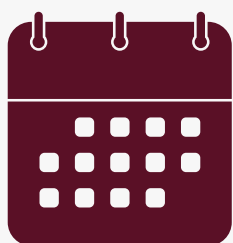
A Heartfelt Thank You to Two Special Teachers
